Summary	Project partners will organise follow-up meetings in order to accompany the innovation transfer process of the previous pilot workshops.

All project partners organised follow-up meetings after the initial pilot innovation workshop. Between 2 and 9 follow-up meetings with in total more than 140 participants attended these meetings.

The follow-up meetings were quite different in their numbers of participants and the corresponding organisation. For each follow-up meeting additional information like agendas, names of participants, locations etc. are available.

These follow-up meetings will continue depending on the status of each “idea” presented and discussed in the initial innovation workshop. Some “ideas” are almost projects, moderated by the respective project partner, between the “idea” project partners, which are the providers of the idea (e. g. medical staff from clinics) and representatives from companies, mainly from SMEs.
